## **Facts**

- 8 connected networks
- Currently migrating from City-Carrier platform to a neutral facility
- Commercial non-competitive operations helps success
- Currently 2 Cisco Catalyst 4000s in operation, a third on standby for hardware replacements and tests
- Only GE-Ports offered
- Private VLANs highly recommended for parties that have "special" peering agreements (such as mutual backup or SLAs)
- KPN Eurorings offers a new product for our local ISP fauna

#### Costs

- one time setup-fee: 100 Euros
- monthly port-fee: 100 Euros (1GE-Port)
- Only GBICs can be purchased by the operator
  - 1000BaseSX : included
  - 1000BaseLX/LH: 100 Euros per piece
  - 1000BaseZX: 1000 Euros per piece
  - 1000BaseTX: 100 Euros per piece
- Participant must organize its own connection (Fibre)
  - 8 different carriers in house, with a 4+ diverse entries

### **Future Plans**

- second location has been selected
- will be connected via 2 diverse city carriers
- Currently 18 GE-ports manageable
  - later, when 15+ members are connected, a new switchplatform might become necessary
- more services, SLAs, options
  - we listen to the demand and maintain our neutrality
  - minimal costs for smaller network operators
  - maximum performance no 10 or 100Mb Ports!
    - 10 GE will not be necessary in the near future = keep it cost effective (etherchannel works fine up to 4-8G)
