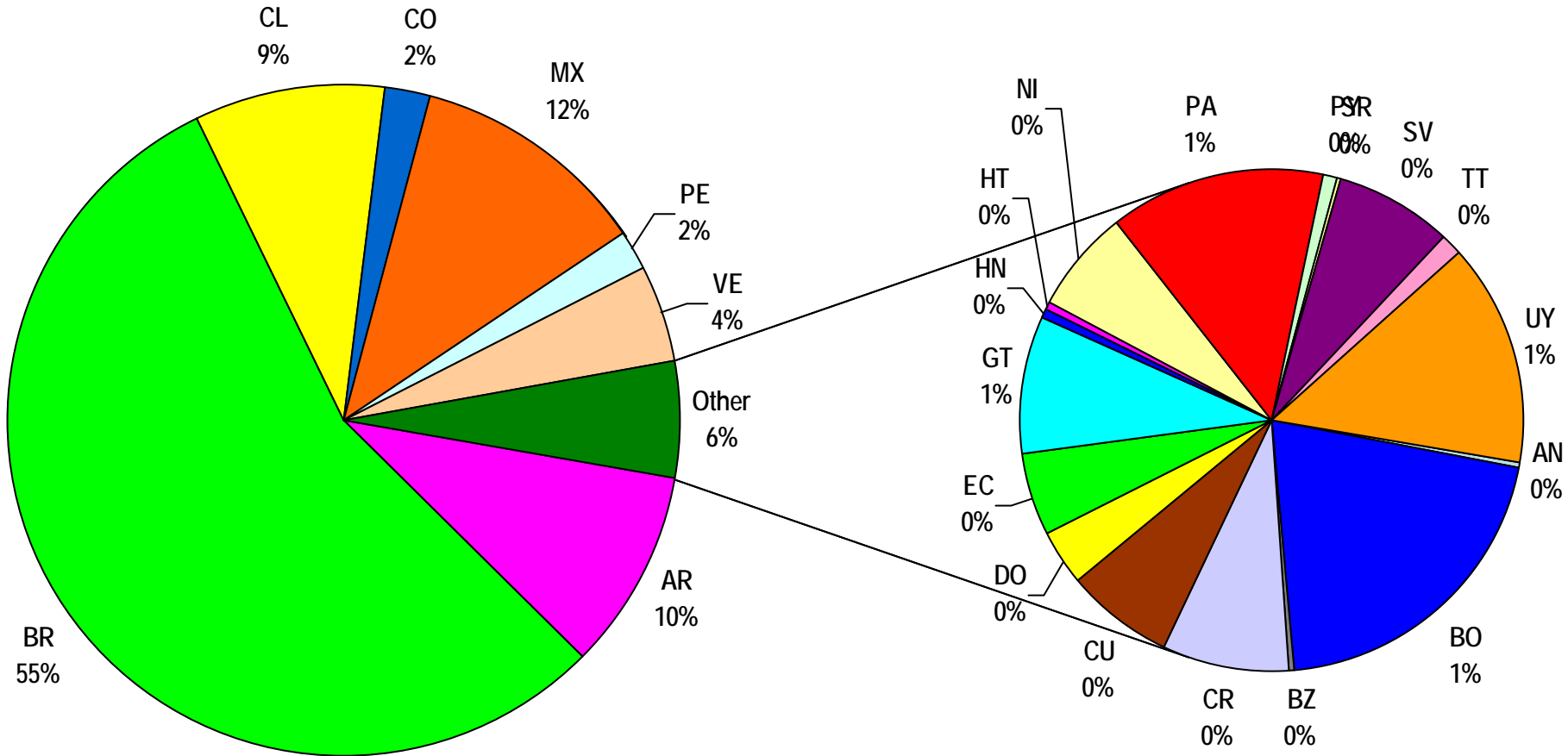

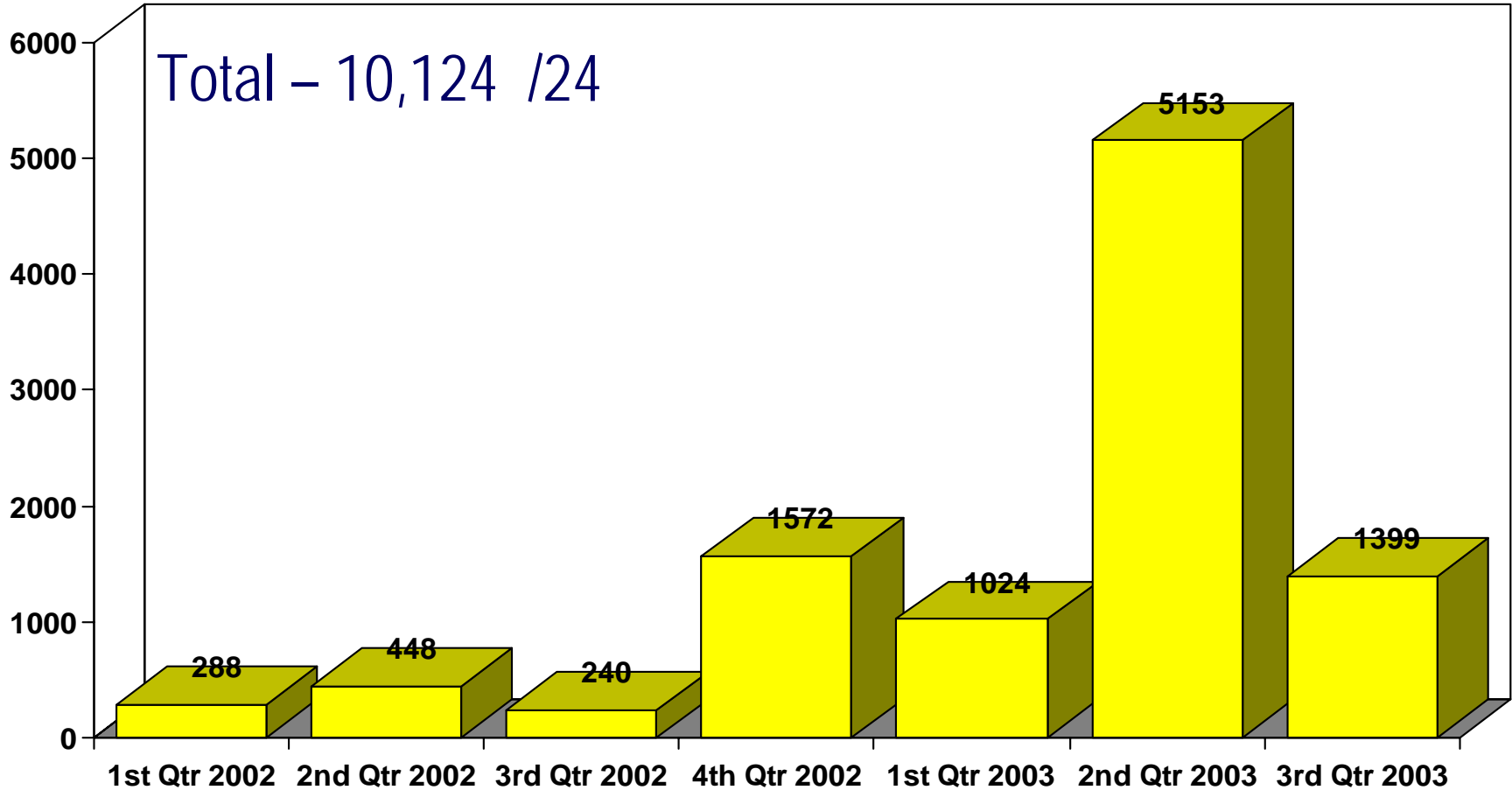

IPv4 DISTRIBUTION BY COUNTRY



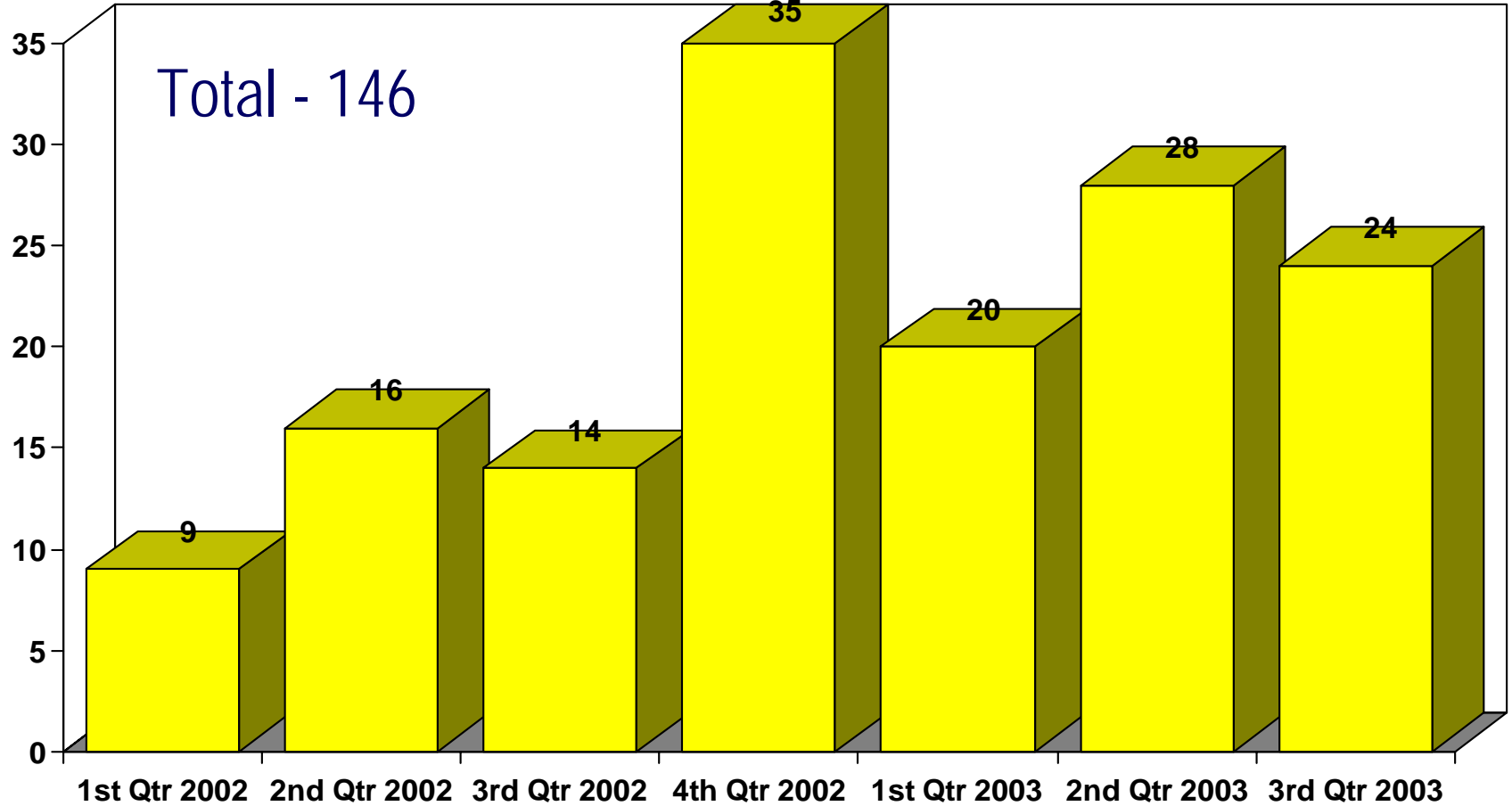
IPv4 /24 ALLOCATED PER QUARTER

1 JAN 2002 – 31 AUG 2003



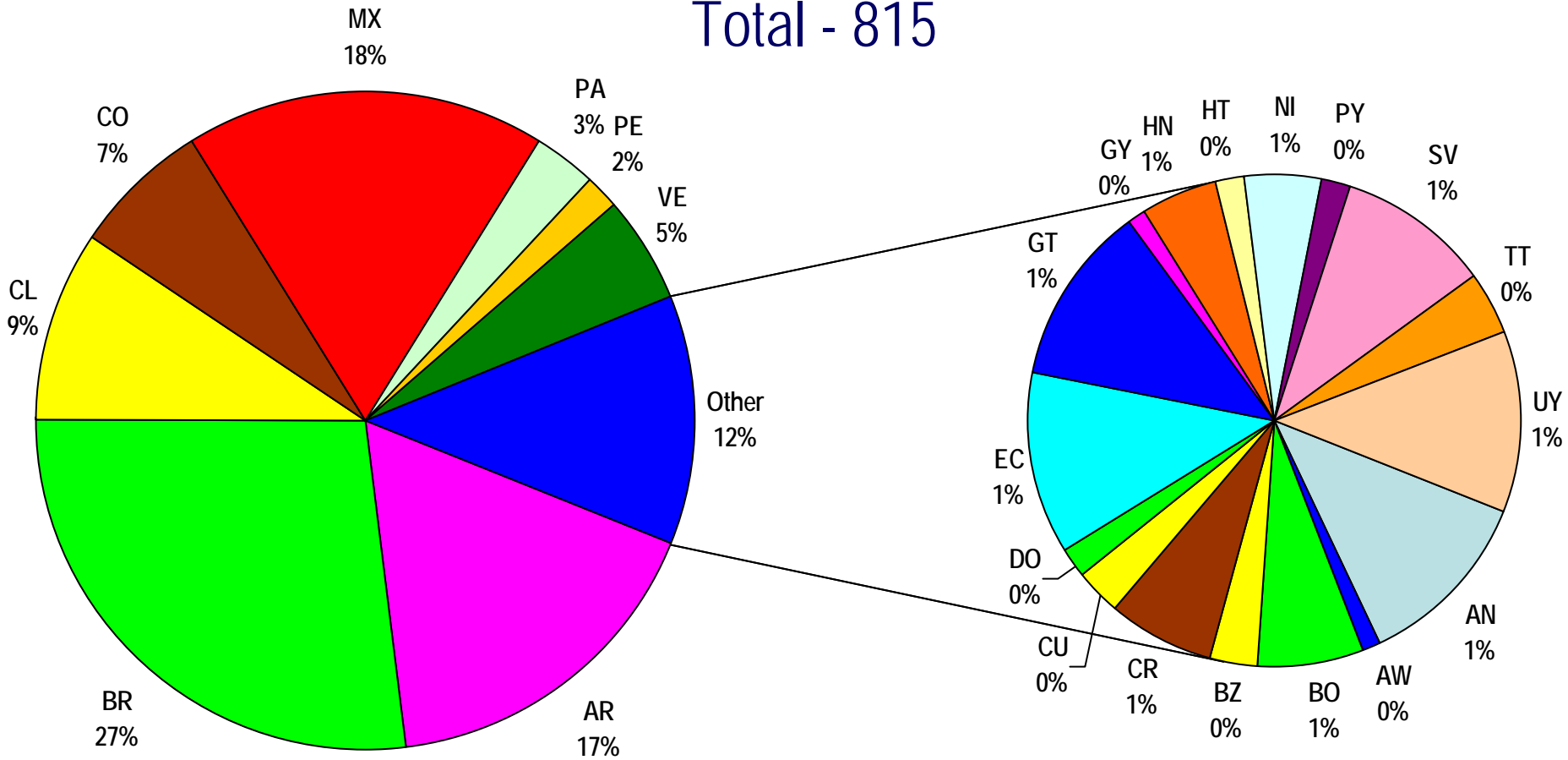
IPv4 ALLOCATIONS PER QUARTER

1 JAN 2002 – 31 AUG 2003



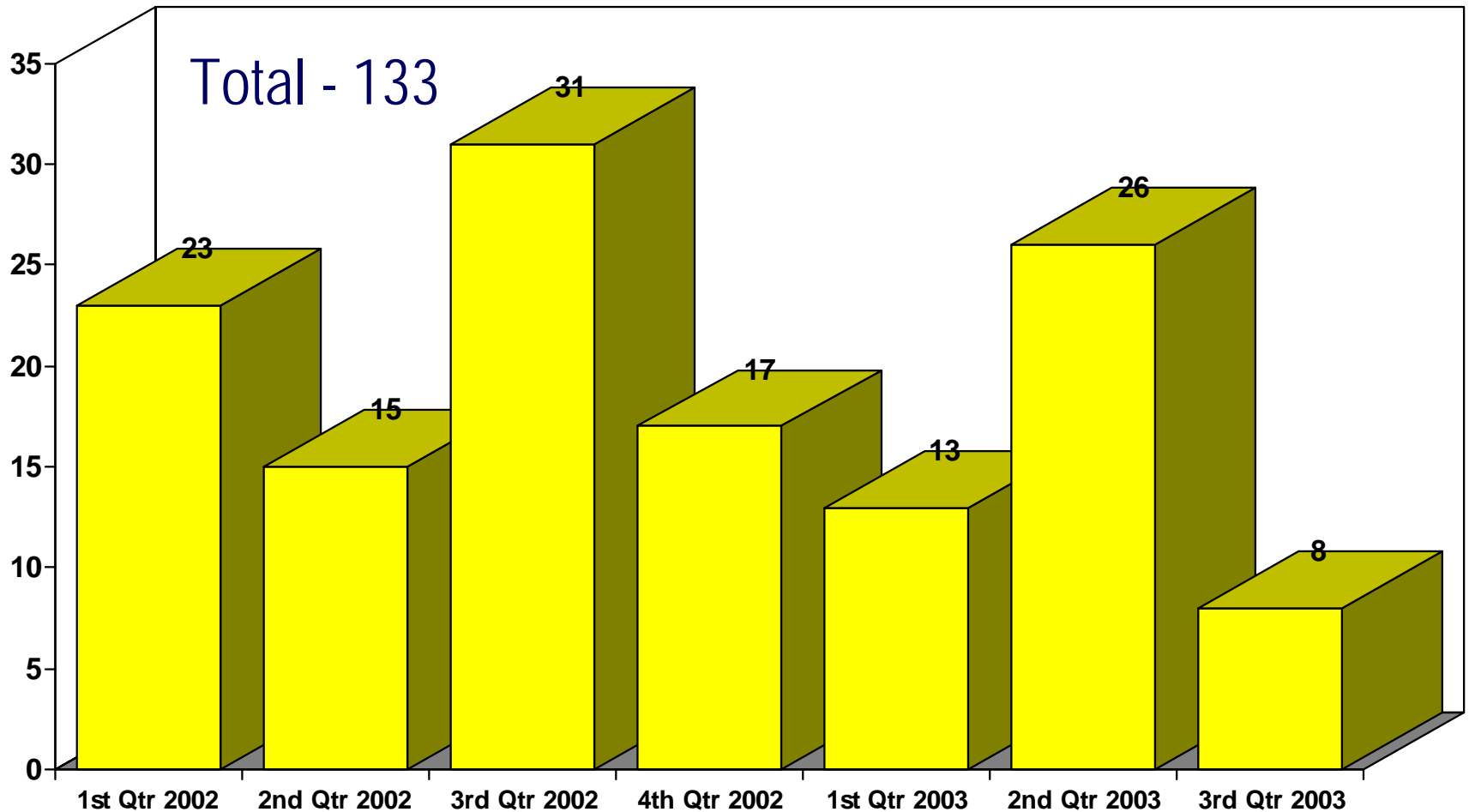
ASN DISTRIBUTION BY COUNTRY

Total - 815

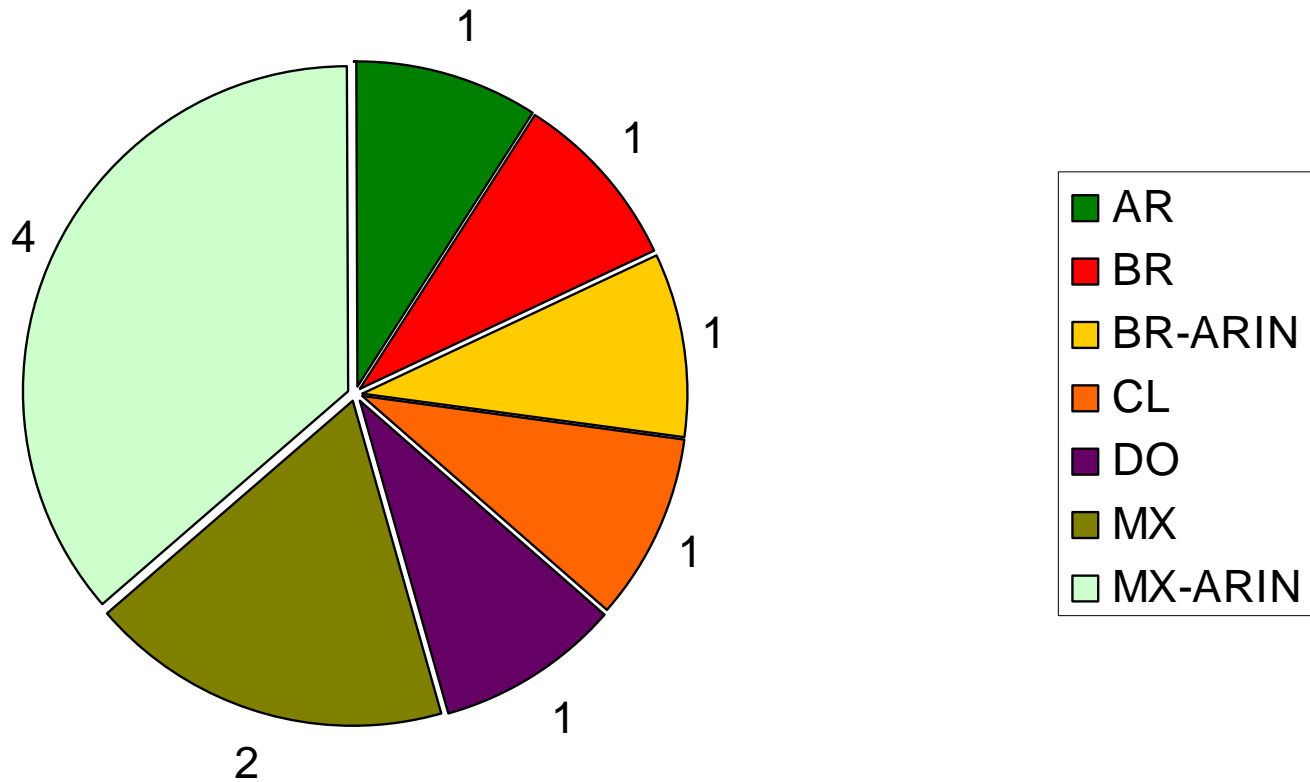


ASN ASSIGNMENT PER QUARTER

1 JAN 2002 – 31 AUG 2003



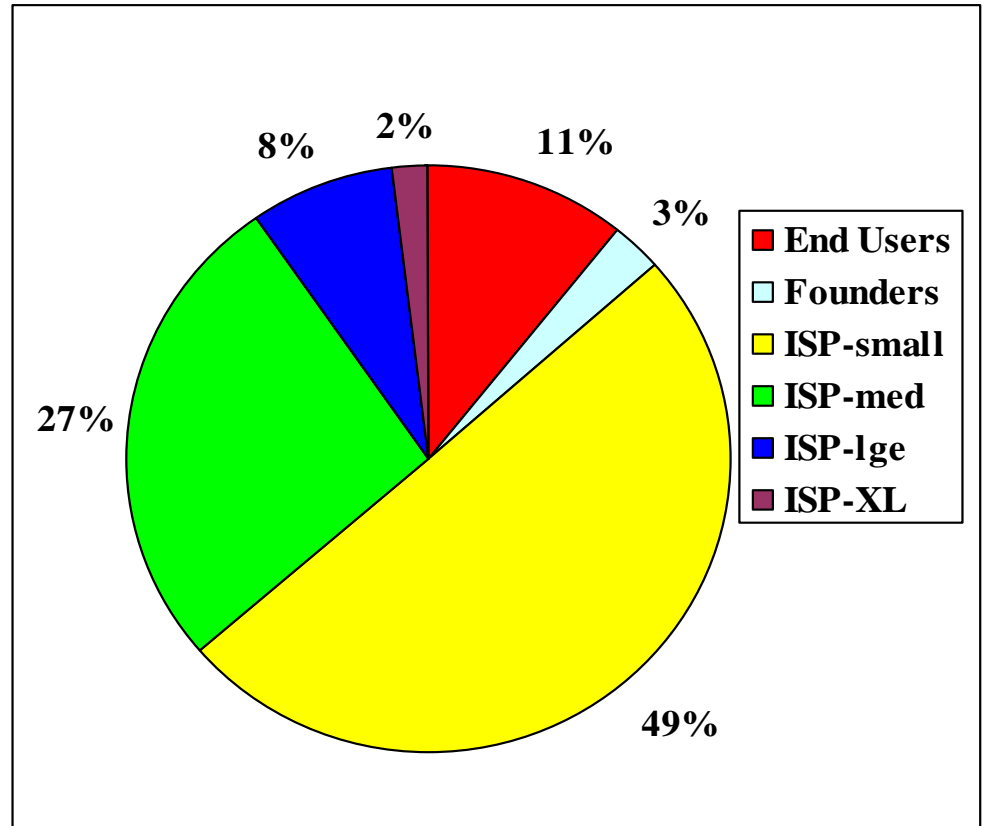
IPv6 DISTRIBUTION BY COUNTRY



11 IPv6 allocations

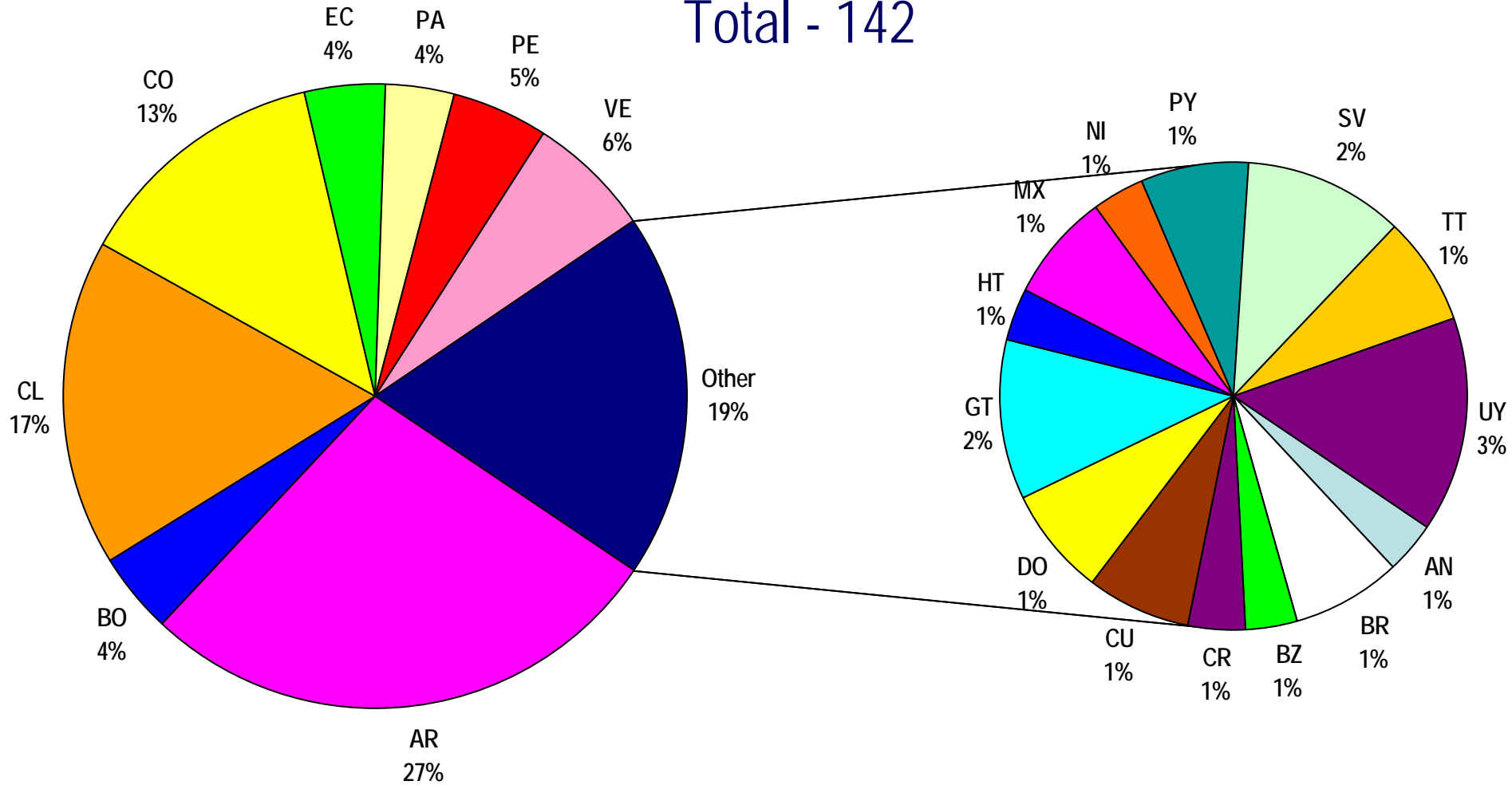

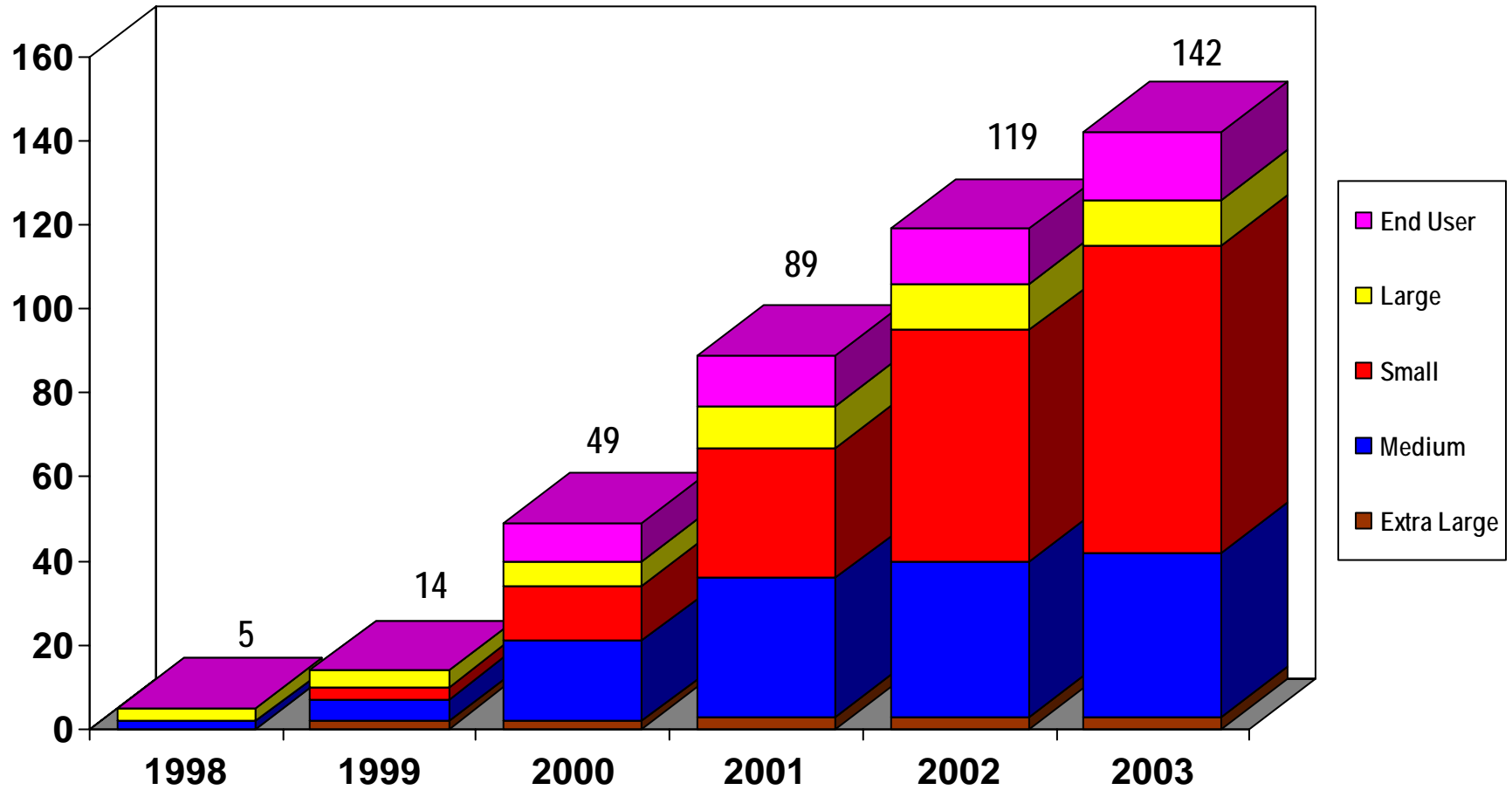
MEMBERSHIP DISTRIBUTION BY COUNTRY

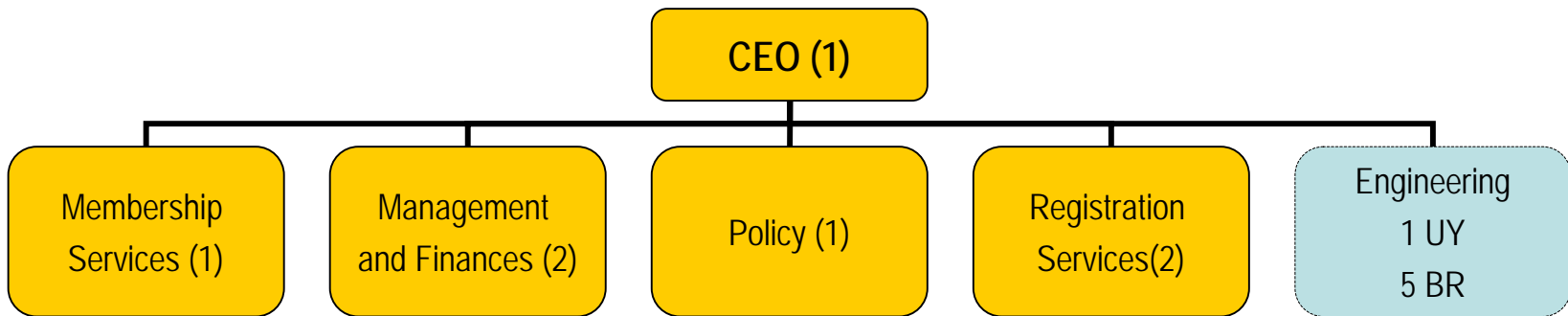
