




- TTM

Database




- Smooth sailing operationally
 - average response time well below 1 second
 - load approximately doubled since last year
- No news is good news!
- Cleanup of unreferenced person objects
 - 35 % / 100 k objects gone
- 70 tickets / day to ripe-dbm@ripe.net
 - 20% done by hostmasters
- Server software 3.2.0 released
- Prototype RPSLNg Server


- k anycast cluster deployment done

Registration Services




- Response Times stable at one to two days for more than a year



Training




- ~110 attendees per month

Course Locations 2003




